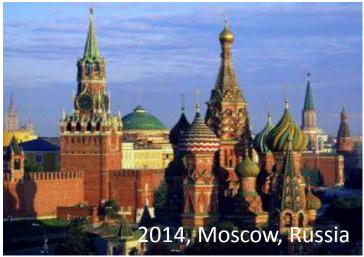

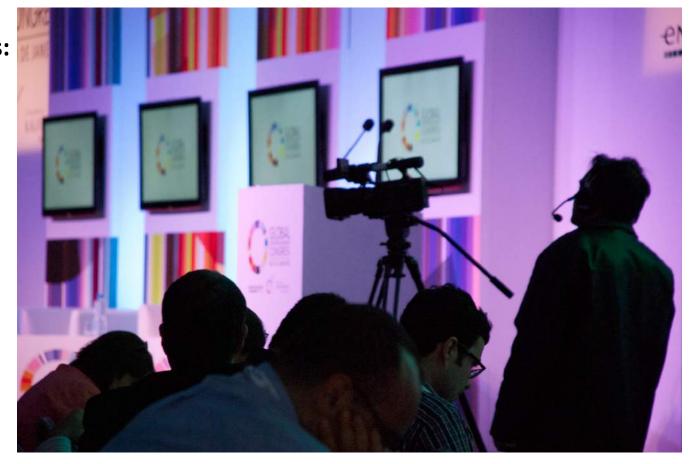

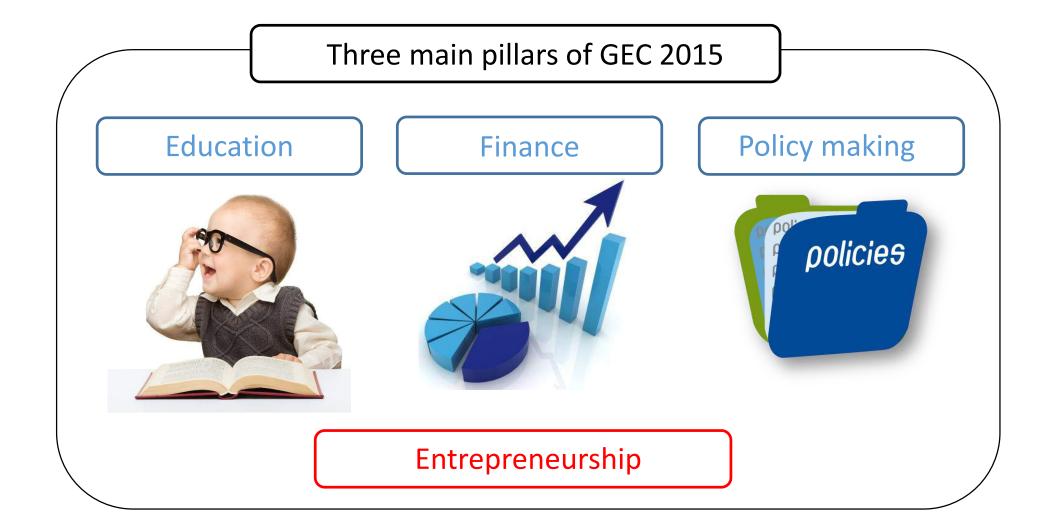

Expo 2015 will involve over **20 million physical visitors, 1 billion virtual visitors and 147 Countries** in exhibitions and thousands of events.

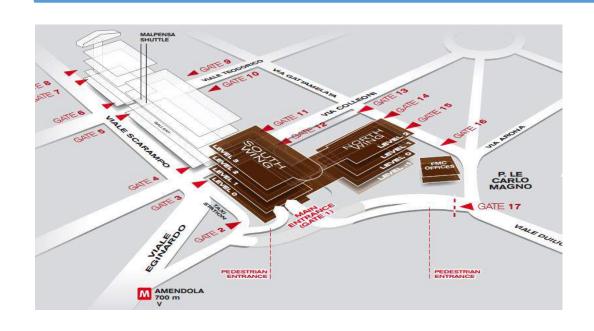

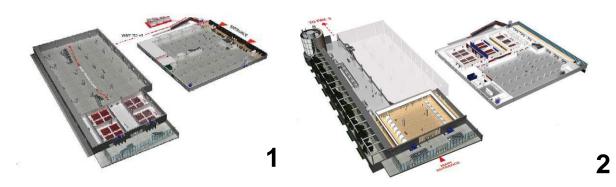


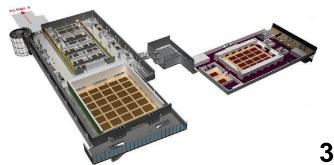


Best facilities in Milan

- ✓ The venue offers 12.000 sq.m and a dedicated exhibition hall of 3.000 sq.m



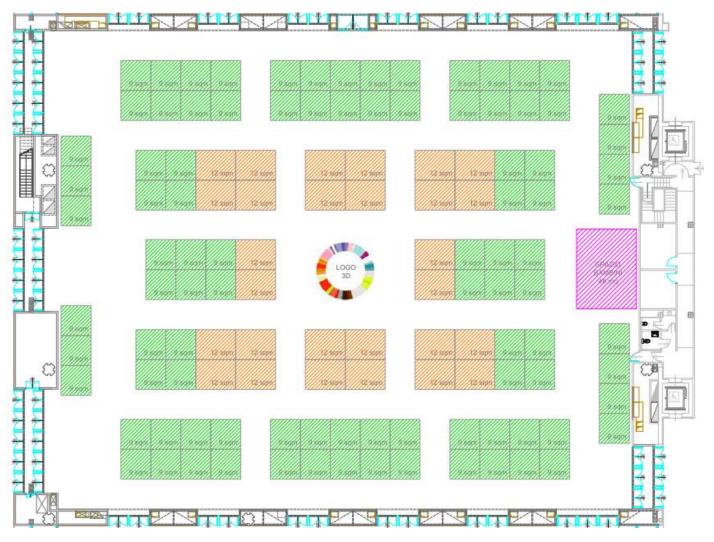




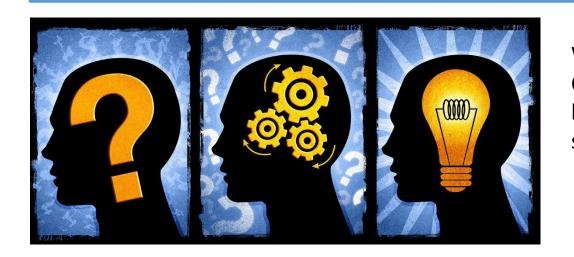
Exhibition Area
